

How can I identify the model and year of my Club Car?

Starting in the 1980s Club Car vehicles have a serial number plaque at the lower edge of the dashboard. The serial number convention is 12 characters and indicates the model, the model year and the production week the vehicle was produced.



For example: PH 0901 -123456 Where PH = PrecedentElectric, 09 = 2009 Model Year, and 01 = First Production Week

Note: If you cannot find a serial number plaque contact Club Car with the serial number from the transaxle, electric motor or gas engine. Utilizing that information we can assist you with identifying the serial number of your vehicle.

A = DS Electric Golf Car

AA = DS Electric Golf Car, 48 Volt

AB = DS Electric Golf Car, 36 Volt

AC = DS Electric Golf Car, 48 Volt Regen

AQ = DS Electric IQ 48 Volt Regen

AG = DS Gasoline Golf Car

PG = Precedent Gasoline Golf Car

PQ = Precedent Electric IQ 48 Volt Golf Car



Club Car DS 1982 - 2000.5

- 1. Two separate seat backs
- 2. Armrests are rubber coated round tube
- 3. Silver aluminum roof supports
- 4. Thin plastic roof with no grab handles
- 5. Serial Number can be found just under the passenger side glove box





Club Car DS 2000.5 - Current

- 1. Solid seat back cushion
- 2. Molded plastic triangular shaped arm rests
- 3. Black roof supports
- 4. Molded plastic roof with grab handles
- 5. Serial Number located on a sticker located under the passenger side glove box.

Club Car Precedent 2004 - Current

- 1. 360 Degree Wrap Around Bumper
- 2. Molded plastic rear roof supports for water drainage
- 3. Serial Number located on a sticker inside the passenger side glove compartment or just under the passenger side glove compartment on the kick panel
